In February 2011, four-year-old Emma was diagnosed with high risk neuroblastoma. This is a rare form of cancer that mainly affects children under the age of five. Emma has been undergoing aggressive treatment at Manchester Royal Children’s Hospital since diagnosis and the course of treatment ends in October. Following this treatment she needs a further six months of immunotherapy. To have the best chance of survival Emma needs to have this treatment in the U.S.A. The cost of this is in excess of £210,000 depending on any extra treatment she may need.
